WELCOME TO THE 2023 MEMBER – GUEST GOLF TOURNAMENT

This year's committee is JP and Bethaney Phillips, Mel and Linda Anderson and Bob and Liz Larman. We are happy you decided to play and will be glad to assist you during the tournament. One of us will be around all weekend and are ready to help if you have any questions. We will have activities Friday, Saturday and Sunday. This information sheet should give you an idea of what to expect this weekend. ***Once again welcome and have fun!***

FRIDAY

Friday is open to all golfers for a practice round. The club house/bar will be open and registration will begin at 10 am. Lunch and dinner will be available for purchase. There will be a ***Horserace, Long Drive and Chipping contest.***

Horserace: If you signed up for the horserace, we would like to start getting organized around 3:00pm. Tee off will be at 4:00pm. The number of groups will depend on how many players have signed up. We will get started as soon as we can to allow time for the Long Drive and Chipping contests that will follow. The ***format*** will be a true alternate shot, with the ball played down and all putts holed. High scores will be eliminated.

Long Drive: We will have two divisions this year, those 64 and under and those 65 and older. All play will be from the #1 tee box. The player with the longest drive landing in the fairway or on the green will win 80% of the over all pot for their division.

Chipping Contest: The chipping contest will be held on hole #9, after the horserace. Each player will get one chip from a designated circle. The player closest to the pin will win 80% of the overall pot.

SATURDAY

Format for Saturdays play will be low ball. The morning groups will tee off at 7:30am, ***(please pay attention to your speed of play as we hope to get the afternoon groups off by 1pm).*** Saturday's team score will be used for Sunday's flighting. There will be ***hole prizes***, included in your entry fee, as well as optional buy in ***Skins*** and ***Birdie pool*** during Saturday's play.

Hole Prizes: There will be hole prizes on holes #2, #3, #6 and #7. For holes with longest putt, you do not need to be on in regulation. The longest putt is the longest putt for the longest put to count you must be on the green (putting on the fringe does not count). Closest to the pin holes will be from the tee box, or in regulation.

Hole #2 – Closest to the pin (From the tee box)

Hole #3 – Longest putt

Hole #6 – Longest putt

Hole #7 – closest to the pin (From the tee box)

Skins: \$20 per team, the pot will be awarded to the team that is the sole winner of a hole. If more than one hole is won by a single team the pot will be divided equally.

Birdie Pool: This is an optional contest, \$10.00 per person with 100% payback. Make a birdie on hole # 5 or hole #14 and win the pot. If more than one team has a birdie on hole #5 or #14 the money will be equally divided.

Mulligans: Mulligans are optional at \$20 per person. If purchased you can take 1 mulligan per nine holes on Saturday (per person), but only one mulligan per 18 holes on Sunday (per person).

Rules of Play: The ball will be played up on the entire course. If your swing, or stance is impeded by a tree, you may take **1 Club Length** relief without moving closer to the hole. If in the rough stay in the rough. All putts will be given inside the leather.

Tee Markers: Play will be from the **WHITES** on the front 9 and **BLUES** on the back 9. Players 65 and older play **WHITE/WHITE Except on HOLE NUMBER 5. 65 and older will play RED Tees for hole number 5 on the front 9 ONLY!**

Ladies Brunch and Fruity Mimosas will be Saturday from 11am to 1pm at the Clay Center Country Club dining room.

At the conclusion of play on Saturday there will be a buffet in the upstairs dining room starting at **6:30PM**. All members and their guest are welcome. This meal is complimentary with your entry fee. If you have other guests that are not playing, but would like to join us for dinner please have one of the staff members make you a ticket for each meal. Following dinner Saturday evening we will announce the pairings and flights for Sunday's scramble.

Stick around for fun and entertainment Saturday night!! Hole prize, Birdie Pool, Skins, Horserace money awarded, and we will have a raffle and other activities.

SUNDAY

Format for Sundays play will be a two-person scramble. The morning groups will tee off at 7:30am, **(please pay attention to your speed of play as we hope to get the afternoon groups off by 1pm)**. The rules of play are the same as Saturday. We will pay the winners of morning flights at the conclusion of their play. All ties will be determined by handicap hole play.
